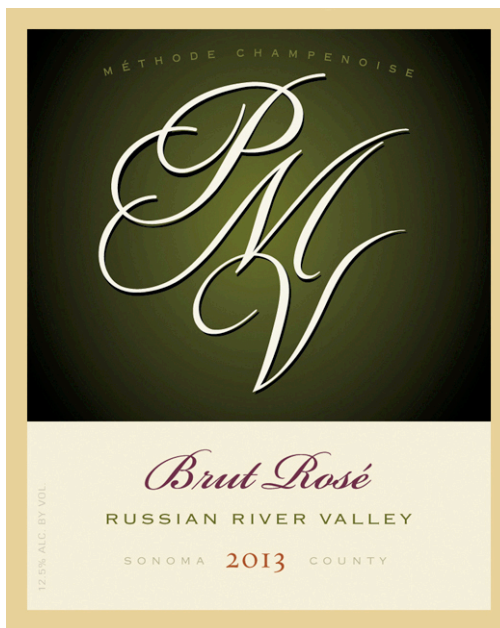

Winemaking Philosophy

We are committed to low input winemaking utilizing uninoculated primary fermentation and malolactic fermentation. Low input winemaking also includes gravity flow movements of wine, minimal acid adjustments, minimal SO₂ additions, racking only once in barrel, no fining and no filtering when possible. This process is much slower and more time consuming but produces wine lush on the palate with seamless flavors.

Winemaking

The 2013 growing season was steady temperatures with very little rain. The warmest year in a decade led to an early harvest with sound fruit, great structure and balance. Grapes were picked August 22nd, whole cluster pressed to tank for 24 hour settling. Native yeast fermentation finished October 24th, very long and slow. Went to bottle in March and was on terage for 20 months and disgouged and finished in October.

Winemakers Notes

100% Pinot Noir showing a beautiful watermelon pink with perfect tiny bubbles. Bright and fresh pink grapefruit, strawberry with a delightful prickle of sparkles.
