Winemaking Philosophy

We are committed to low input winemaking utilizing uninoculated primary fermentation and malolactic fermentation. This process is much slower and more time consuming but produces wine lush on the palate with seamless flavors. Low input winemaking also includes gravity flow movements of wine, minimal acid adjustments, minimal SO2 additions, racking only once in barrel, no fining and no filtering when possible.

Vineyards

TnT is a 2 acre vineyard from a combo of Dijon clones. This vineyard on Occidental road in the Green Valley sub appellation of Russian River.

Wild Hog vineyard is in the Fort Ross / Seaview AVA in Cazadero. This vineyard is owned by Dan Schoenfield planted over a period thirty – forty years ago. Certified organic and dry farmed. Elevation is 1400 feet in the hills above Cazadero.

Winemaking

40% whole cluster between combination of the two vineyards. Blend was made two weeks prior to bottling August 29<sup>th</sup> 2024.

Tasting Notes

Big bowl of wild berries, great representation of Russian River with sarsaparilla, red and black fruits of cherry, pomegranate, wild ripe strawberry, red vines. Balanced acidity with rounded mouth feel for a long finish
